## Northern California Retina Vitreous Associates What to Expect after an Intravitreal Injection:

- 1. Tearing and irritation are very common. This may last a few days.
- 2. Redness (bright red bruise around injection site) may last up to a week.
- 3. Floaters usually are due to a small air bubble that may last up to a week.
- 4. It is okay to shower.

## What you should do:

1. Please use artificial tears to help soothe the surface of the eye. These are available at most pharmacies and are over-the-counter.

## **What to AVOID:**

- 1. Do not rub the eye. You may use a gentle tissue to wipe the eye.
- 2. Do not go swimming for 2 days.

## Please contact your Doctor if you experience any of the following Signs of Infection:

- 1. Severe pain
- 2. If you feel like your vision is worsening.
- 3. Increased redness that is worsening.
